Friday, July 12th – Bible Study – Jason Fritts – “Proving God Exists” – a comprehensive review of the story flow of the Bible. The Bible is the confirmation of God’s Plan, and without it, we would have nothing but a theory. Without God Himself, stepping out from behind the curtain and revealing Himself, with the answers to life’s greatest questions, we would have nothing but theories and speculation. We’ll walk from Genesis, to the life of Christ, continuing to establish the Bible as God’s authoritative Word.

Saturday, July 13th – Sermonette – Matthew Kidney – “Shake It Off.” **The Old Mule in the Well** If we face our problems, respond to them positively, and refuse to give into panic, bitterness, or self-pity, the ADVERSITIES that come along to BURY us usually have within them, the potential to benefit us, bless us and help us grow.

The evening before His execution, Jesus victoriously announced, “...I have overcome the world” (**John 16:33**). The next day, standing before Pilate, Jesus declared, “My kingdom is not of this world” (**John 18:36**). What did He mean by “world”? What is the “world” Christians are instructed not to love (**I John 2:15**). One of the Bible definitions of “pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this...to keep oneself unspotted from the world” (**James 1:27**). In the Bible Study we will get a better idea of what this means by looking at the parable of the sower. Christians are told that they must remain in the world, and yet not be part of it. But just how far should you go in avoiding the world’s ways. We will take a look at four main pitfalls we need to consider, and how to respond. Joseph knew how he should respond. By the end of this study should we.
